

## **KEY STAGE 1 RESULTS 2016**

In Key Stage 2 this year, the children have been the first cohort to take tests from the new national curriculum. These tests are not measured in 'levels' like previous years, making comparisons difficult. Therefore, the measure that we have used is to compare our results to the national average in terms of how many children achieved the 'Expected Standard' set by the government. They also measure how many children are working at a 'Greater Depth' a more advanced stage of learning.
